Intake Information Evening – Monday 30th June 2025

We invite all our new families and students to our Intake Evening on **Monday 30th June 2025**. The intake presentation will take place at **6.00pm** in the main hall and will be led by our **Principal, Mr Hodgson** and **Head of Year 7 and Transition, Mrs Imrie**.

This is an important evening as we formally welcome you to the Hagley Catholic High School family. We strongly encourage you to attend as you will be able to meet your child's Head of Year and other key staff.

In addition to the Intake presentation at 6.00pm the evening will also include the following:

- Our school uniform suppliers will be based in the sports hall from 3.00pm - 5.30pm and will re-open at 6.45pm, after the Principal's presentation.
- Representatives from Endeavour Coaches will join us if you need to sign up for the dedicated school bus service or have any questions about bus routes.
- Our Admissions Team will be available to meet you to answer any queries about admissions or the use of Arbor.
- A second-hand uniform sale will also be available, and we will also be selling pencil case starter kits and scientific calculators, all essential provisions for life at secondary school and at wholesale prices.
- Our **SEND**CO; **Ms Hackett**, will be available throughout the evening in the Hub. At **5.15pm** in **FF1**, she will deliver a presentation outlining what you can expect from SEND provision at secondary school.
- Our Lead First Aider will be available, should you need to discuss any of your child's medical conditions.

Transition Days - Wednesday 2nd, Thursday 3rd & Friday 4th July 2025

This year we welcome all our new students for a three-day transition programme, designed to ensure our students are nurtured and supported as we welcome them to life at Hagley Catholic High School. We recognise what a big step this can be for some of our students, and whilst we hope our new students are excited to join us, we understand there can naturally be nerves and apprehension; our three-day programme will allow students to find their feet and begin to settle into secondary school life.

Students will spend the three days in their new tutor groups and take part in a range of transition activities and lessons, as well as finding their way around the school and learning some school routines. We hope the transition days will also afford students to time to bond with new friends and meet new staff.

We ask that students wear their primary school uniform each day, bring a packed lunch, a refillable water bottle and something to write with. Students will be greeted each day by our staff and should be in school by 8.45am each morning where they will gather under the canopy area. On Wednesday and Thursday, we will finish at 3.00pm and on Friday we will finish at the earlier time of 2.00pm. Any students who will be departing with siblings are welcome to wait until 3.25pm when the official school day ends, they will be supervised in this time.
